#### **Ravine Poisson Public Sanitation Facility Replacement**

On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2015 the St. Lucia Social Development Fund (SSDF) held an official contract signing ceremony for the 'Ravine Poisson Public Sanitation Facility Replacement'. This project is being funded by the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB)

and is worth E.C. \$ 463,396.42. Work on this project is ongoing and is expected to be carried out over the upcoming 3 month period.

Amarna's role on this project is to design and supervise the progress of the project.

On October 28th, 2015, the St. Lucia Social Development Fund (SSDF) with funding from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) signed a contract with WASCO for the Belvedere to Bouton Water Extension Project. This project is aimed at providing a reliable and consistent supply of water to residents of Bouton for the very first time. Amarna Consult Ltd will supervise the project on behalf of the CDB.
